SCOPE:

This method is used to evaluate resoiling characteristics of spot and stain remover chemical residue on a standard carpet sample.

GENERAL PRINCIPLE:

An area of the standard test carpet is treated with a specific application of the test chemical and allowed to dry. The treated sample is then subjected to accelerated soiling in accordance with ASTM D6540. The visible difference of the treated area of the test sample versus the untreated area is assessed in accordance with AATCC Evaluation Procedure 2, using the AATCC Gray Scale for Staining.
